Welcome to Spanish! Throughout this course, you will explore the Spanish language and culture. Through a variety of activities, we will practice reading, writing, listening to, and speaking Spanish as well as exploring the culture of several Spanish speaking countries.

EXPECTATIONS:

GRADES:

I will regularly post grades to Parent Portal. If you are unable to access Parent Portal, please let me know so that I can send out a copy of the grades.

Minor Assessment (Quizzes and Projects):

- Minor assessments include quizzes, class work and other mastery checks. Students can expect at least one minor assessment each week.

Major Assessments (Tests):

- Major assessments include tests and other cumulative assignments. Students can expect at least two major assessments each quarter.

Skills Assessments (Reading, Writing, Speaking, Listening):

- Students will be assessed periodically on their ability to understand and present information in Spanish. These assessments may or may not be announced.

Homework:

- Practice is critical in mastery of Spanish and students should expect to have 20 minutes of homework nightly. Although homework is not calculated into the overall grade, it will be checked daily and feedback will be posted to Parent Portal.

SPANISH WEBSITE/ABSENCES:

It is the responsibility of the **student** to obtain notes and assignments missed during an absence. In case of an absence, students should access homework and class work information through the **DDMS Spanish** website (It is under the Fine Arts tab on the DDMS website). Any work that is not attached to the website will be distributed upon return. (www.ddmsspanish.weebly.com)

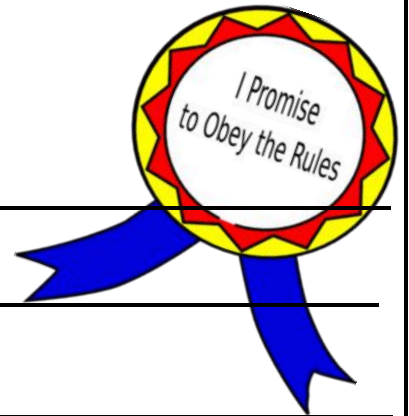
